Re: Rugby World Cup 2011

Greetings from Wellington, New Zealand,

The Rugby World Cup will be staged in New Zealand in September and October 2011.

Most hotels in the major cities are already fully booked. Please advise your members who wish to stay at the Wellington Club in Wellington during this period that bookings should be made now. Some of these weekends are also already fully booked at the Club.

During this period accommodation is at a premium. This is also reflected in the prices charged. Some hotels have increased their room prices tenfold. The Committee of the Wellington Club has now decided on the Club's charges for those particular weekends.

- The weekend room rate per night **during the pool games** in September (9 - 11, 16 - 18, 23 - 25 and 30 - 2 October) will be **NZ\$250** inclusive of GST (at 15%), cooked breakfast and car park. A standard reciprocal fee of 10% will be added to the final bill of members from reciprocal clubs. **A minimum booking of two nights per room applies.**
- The weekend room rate per night during the **quarter finals** in October (7 - 9) will be **NZ\$400** inclusive of GST (at 15%), cooked breakfast and car park. A standard reciprocal fee of 10% will be added to the final bill of members from reciprocal clubs. **A minimum booking of three nights per room applies.**

Conditions: The room rate is applicable for either single or double occupancy.

A 20% non-refundable deposit of all room nights booked is due upon booking of the room(s).

Bookings must be accompanied by a valid credit card and full contact details.

Cancellations will be accepted and deposits reimbursed (less commission fees) when received within 28 days before the booking.

Cancellations received less than 28 days before the booking will not be accepted and the full price will be charged, if the rooms cannot be re-let.

The Wellington Club does not normally operate on such a stringent cancellation policy. However, accommodation in the city will be in high demand and policies have to be put in place to maximise occupancy.
